Team members must be declared prior to the first member shooting. Team members do not have to fire on the same relay. To qualify for national ranking and awards, all team members must be in the same category, but need not have the same classification. Teams must be comprised of members of the same club.

Triggers must meet NRA pistol rule 3.4 requiring "Trigger pull not less than 2 pounds." Random checks may be made.

All visitors to Southport, whether shooting or not, will be required to sign a "Release and Indemnification" form.

SECTIONAL AWARD SCHEDULE:

Awards will be provided by the NRA for the Sectional Individual and Team matches on the following basis:

Individual – If there are fewer than 5 entries in a category, they will be combined with entries of another category within the same class. If there are fewer than 5 entries after combining all the categories of a class, there will be NO AWARDS provided in that class. All competitors will be moved to their respective categories and combined with the next higher class. Competitors of lower classifications will not be combined with the High Master Class. If fewer than 5 entries in the High Master Class, they will compete for open awards only.

Team – NRA will provide awards at the Sectional level for the Open Winning Team only. 20 NRA Award Points (5 Points per team member). There will be no local awards for the team match.

An individual or team winning an open award will not be entitled to a class award in the same match. Such awards will be passed down to the next eligible individual or team.

1 st in class`	5 NRA Award Points
2 nd in class (10-19)	4 NRA Award Points
3 rd in class (20 up)	3 NRA Award Points

SECTIONAL INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:

- Winner – Gold Sectional Medallion and 15 NRA Award Points
- Second – Silver Sectional Medallion and 10 NRA Award Points
- Third – Bronze Sectional Medallion and 5 NRA Award Points
